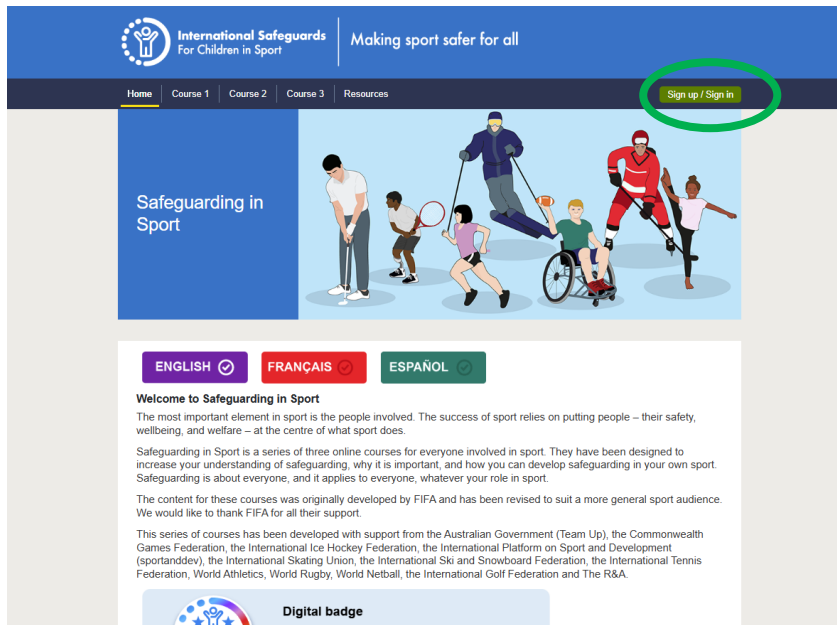

To start the course click [here](#) which will take you to the course homepage. You first need to login with your new details, so click on the sign in button highlighted:




This takes you back to the login page. Enter your email and password and click submit. You should be redirected back to the course home page, but the button will change to say 'my profile'.


